

Establishment of a unit for combating Violence against women

The president of Alexandria University has issued an act to establish a unit for combating violence against women in the faculty of Art . The The First Forum entitled “ She Against Violence” was organised under the patronage of President of Alexandria University, and in partnership with the National Council for Women and the Anti-Violence Unit at Alexandria University and the Taha Hussein Center for Disabled Services at the university.

The Forum kicked off the opening session explaining the objective of the center. In the same context, a psychiatric and legal sessions were held, with lectres about the challenges women face .

Then the forum moved to the Taha Hussein Center to start the evening activities, and it began with a session of violence against nymphs, or women of determination.

The last session was dedicated to the participation of the Cinema Club of the Faculty of Arts in the forum and several films were shown about violence cases. The session started by a view of Arabic literature on the relationship between men and women, then the movie (Tuk Tok) was

Then the meeting concluded with a session of recommendations.

The forum was attended by the students of the university, the Students’ Union at the College of Arts and representatives of all the families in the union, as well as a group of college professors, deputies of the faculties of Education, Physical Education and Medicine, and the Dean of the College of Islamic Studies at Al-Azhar University, as well as a group of the Alexandrian community, the press and the media.

This unit has several activities among which is an entrepreneursh workshop for women focusing on the pedological innovations and technology Enhanced learning.

The center has circulated a questionnaire fro all women attended to analyse different cases violence and build a data base of that help in diagnosing such cases and ways of treatment.
