



## Alexandria University policy for disabled students and staff

**Accessibility of Facilities:** Universities strive to ensure that their facilities, including classrooms, libraries, laboratories, and dormitories, are accessible to all individuals, including those with physical disabilities. This involves providing ramps, elevators, accessible restrooms, and other features to accommodate mobility needs.


