



A full scholarship in the joint degree program between Alexandria and Manchester Medicine in Britain for the first student in high school at the Republic level under the system STEM

Within the framework of Alexandria University's strategy to support academically distinguished students, enhance their spirit of belonging, care for them, motivate them to continue their excellence, and provide opportunities for the benefit of the student and society, the Alexandria University Council, headed by Prof. Abdel Aziz Konsowa, President of Alexandria University, agreed to grant scholarships to the student Osama Muhammad Saad Maharem, a student in the Egyptian Secondary School. At the School of Excellence in Science and Technology for boys in the STEM system in Borg El Arab, and who won first place nationwide in the Egyptian secondary school, he received a scholarship in the joint academic degree program between the Faculty of Medicine of Alexandria University and its counterpart at the University of Manchester in the United Kingdom



to study for the academic year 2022/2023, and he was exempted from paying special annual tuition fees. On the Egyptian side, which is estimated at about 9 thousand dollars annually, and coordination is underway with the English side in this regard. The university president confirmed that the student has a strong desire to join this study program, and the university responded to his request by providing a distinguished study opportunity for free in appreciation of his excellence.».
