Alexandria University offers social and Medical services to rural populations in villages that are in extreme need .

The committee of community Development and Environmental development at Alexandria University are reviewing the social and medical convoys for serving most villages in need.



The Council for Community Service and Environmental Development headed by Dr. Ashraf Al-Ghandour, Vice President of Alexandria University, will present during its meeting, today 9/21/2022, the report submitted by Dr. Manal Fouda, Executive Director of the Unit for Combating Violence against Women, on the unit's activity and the most important activities in which it participated, such as the convoy Community outreach to the Abis 7.



The Council reviewed the report submitted by Dr. Wafaa El-Sahly, rapporteur and coordinator of medical convoys at Alexandria University, about the university's organization of a medical convoy to King Mariout to serve 11 villages with the participation of some civil society institutions, the National Council for Women, the Volunteer Life Foundation and a team "For You" at the Faculty of Medicine. The total number of cases that were diagnosed reached 775, as well as a report on the Apis 7 convoy that reached a total number of 603 cases. It was reported that some cases were transferred to university hospitals to complete health care for them.



Alexandria University launches an expanded medical convoy to the most needy villages in Beheira Governorate- August 2022



Under the patronage of Dr. Mostafa Madbouly, Prime Minister, and the supervision of Major General Hisham Amna, "Governor of Beheira," and Prof. Abdelaziz Konsowa, "President of Alexandria University," the expanded medical convoy launched this morning, Thursday, August 4, to the most needy villages, organized by the Supreme Medical and Distress Committee of the Council of Ministers and Alexandria University. And the Sonaa Al-Khair Foundation for Development, in cooperation with the Directorate of Health Affairs in Beheira, to treat patients who are unable to afford state expenses in the village of Al-Akreisha in the center and city of Kafr Al-Dawwar in Beheira Governorate in a number of different medical specialties.

Dr. Wafaa Al-Sahli, coordinator of medical convoys at Alexandria University and former vice dean of the Faculty of Medicine for community service and environmental development, stated

that the total number of cases that were detected reached 2,377 various medical cases in specialties, including 370 cases of ophthalmia, 50 eye operations were performed, 125 medical glasses were donated, and 82 prescriptions were dispensed. Medical, as well as 170 dental examinations, 60 brain and nerve examinations, 80 women's 250 examinations. children's cases, 70 heart diseases, 170 chest diseases, 90 surgery, 190 dermatology, 270 bones, 140 internal and endemic diseases, 100 nose and ears, 70 urology and 165 procedures. Medical tests and detection of 134 cases



within the Women's Health Initiative, 48 cases of kidney disease within the Chronic Disease Detection Initiative..



Alexandria University organizes a medical convoy to Burg El Arab Area

Academic year 2022-2023

Under the auspices of Professor Dr. Abdelaziz Konsowa, President of Alexandria University, and under the supervision of the Community Service and Environmental Development Sector headed by Dr. Saeed Allam, the Faculties of Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, the Medical Research Institute, and the Higher Institute of Health at the University of Alexandria, in collaboration with the "Doctor for You" fraternity at the Faculty of Medicine, organised a

comprehensive therapeutic medical convoy to Borg Al Arab area west of Alexandria to serve the people of the area, and its work continued for six days.

Dr. Wafaa El-Sehli, professor at the Faculty of Medicine and rapporteur of the convoy committee at Alexandria University, stated that the total number of cases that were



treated during the period of the convoy's work amounted to 974 cases in various medical specialties, as follows:

- 1. Internal diseases 254
- 2. Nutrition 26
- 3. Gynaecology 39 and ultrasound 36
- 4. Neurological and Psychological 40
- 5. Heart and blood vessels 32
- 6. Ear, Nose and Throat 110
- 7. Children 163
- 8. Orthopaedics 103
- 9. Chest 41
- 10. Ophthalmology 81
- 11. Dermatology 71
- 12. Surgery 18

13. In addition, 40 cases were transferred to Alexandria University Hospitals to receive specialized medical treatment.



Alexandria University launches a medical convoy to Kom Hamada Center in Beheira July 2023

Under the patronage of Prof. Abdel Aziz Konsowa, President of Alexandria University, and under the supervision of the Community Service and Environmental Development Sector, headed by Dr. Ashraf Al-Ghandour, Acting Vice President of the University for Community Service and Environmental Development, Alexandria University, represented by the Faculties of Human Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy,

and Nursing, organized on Thursday July 13, a comprehensive medical convoy to the Kom Hamada Center in Beheira Governorate, in cooperation with the Abu EI-EIa Charitable Foundation, and the Doctor for You family at the Faculty of Medicine, Alexandria University, to serve the people of the Kom Hamada Center.

Dr. Wafa Al-Sahli, a professor at the Faculty of Medicine and a member of the convoy committee at Alexandria University, stated that the total number of cases that were detected during the convoy's work reached 390 cases in various medical specialties, including 70 skin cases, 43 children's cases, 11 gynecological cases, 62 ophthalmia cases, and 65 orthopedic cases. 80 internal medicine cases, 59 dental cases, and she said that 5 children's cases were transferred to El Shatby University Hospital, and 200 cases were examined for diabetes, with



weight and height measured, as well as blood pressure.
