

## Annual International Conference of Internal Medicine Entitled "Integrative Medicine for the Department of Internal Medicine"

Created: 24 November 2022



On Wednesday the 23rd of November, Dr. Ashraf El-Ghandour, Vice President of Alexandria University for Graduate Studies and Research, and the honorary president of the conference, witnessed the inauguration ceremony of the nineteenth annual conference of the Department of Internal Medicine in Alexandria, at the Great Hall of the Faculty of Medicine. The conference that is taking place on the 23rd and 24th of November, under the title "Integrative Medicine for the Department of Internal Medicine", will present the latest techniques and discoveries in disease prevention, treatment and emergency cases concerning internal medicine, haematology, diabetes, hepatology, gastroenterology, and rheumatism.

The opening session was attended by Dr. Ali Abdel Mohsen, Acting Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, Dr. Ayman El Shayeb, Vice Dean for Postgraduate Studies and Research, Dr. Tamer Abdallah, Executive Director of University Hospitals, Dr. Iman Youssef, Head of the Internal Medicine Department and Conference Chair, Dr. Ezzat Ali, Head of the Digestive System Unit, and Dr. Ahmed Zaid, Head of the Hepatology Unit, and a group of senior professors of internal medicine, international lecturers and students.



In his speech, Dr. Ashraf El-Ghandour stressed that Alexandria University is keen to support and motivate all scientific conferences that discuss and present all that is new in all disciplines related to the departments of internal diseases and haematology at the Faculty of Medicine, in a way that contributes to enriching the medical scene, in cooperation with the rest of the faculty's departments, to achieve what is called "Integrative Medicine" to ensure a successful medical system at the university. Dr. El-Ghandour confirmed that he is proud to be a graduate of the Faculty of Medicine, Alexandria University, specifically the Department of Internal Medicine, as it is one of its oldest departments, that has achieved a qualitative leap in its various sub-specialties in internal and blood diseases. In addition, it includes a group of the greatest professors and great scientists who contributed to the graduation of qualified doctors who in turn took part in the advancement of medicine in Egypt and many Arab countries, and the improvement of health services provided to millions of patients over many years.

Dr. Iman Youssef confirmed that the conference was preceded by several research sessions and discussions at the premises of the Department of Internal Medicine on Tuesday the 22nd of November, with the participation of the department's professors, graduate students and interns. Youssef confirmed that the conference hosts a group of senior professors of haematology, diabetes, hepatology, gastroenterology, and rheumatism, and international lecturers, to discuss integrative medicine between the 8 units of the Department of Internal Medicine and the rest of the clinical departments of the faculty, as well as to discuss the latest methods of diagnosis and treatment in internal diseases and haematology. The participants will also hold scientific sessions and important lectures to discuss the latest types of treatments and medicines, and to shed light on all that is new in the field, whether through presenting scientific research or through workshops that contribute to updating the information of all doctors and keeping abreast of all that is new in various medical specialties.





## The start of the Fourth International Conference of the Faculty of Physical Education for Girls at Bibliotheca Alexandrina

Under the auspices of His Excellency Dr. Ashraf Sobhy, Minister of Youth and Sports, and Professor Dr. Abdelaziz Konsowa, President of Alexandria University, the activities of the Fourth International Scientific Conference of the Faculty of Physical Education for Girls will begin next Sunday, the 11th of December, at the Bibliotheca Alexandrina. The conference entitled "The Reality of Sports and Aspirations for the Future" is organized in partnership with Martin Luther University, the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and the University of Mansoura.

Dr. Maha Amin, Dean of the Faculty and President of the conference, indicated that over the course of three days, the conference will discuss ways to keep pace with scientific developments in sports for people with disabilities, and the current challenges facing the sporting structure, in order to be ready for the future of sports in the Arab world and globally. The conference will also discuss how to upgrade the scientific research strategy in the fields of sports science, ways to activate the role of physical education in schools and universities, mechanisms for activating partnerships between universities and civil society institutions to improve the future of sports, and how to employ electronic technologies in developing the structure of sports sciences.



## The faculty of Economic Studies and Political Science holds its fifth scientific Conference

Under the patronage of Dr. Abdelaziz Konsowa, President of Alexandria University, and under the supervision of Dr. Mohamed Abdel Azim Abul Naga, Acting Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, the Faculty of Economic Studies and Political Science held its fifth scientific conference headed by Dr. Ahmed Wahban, Dean of the Faculty, Dr. Osama Al-Adly and Dr. Sherine Nassir As Vice-Presidents, and Dr. Nabil Salah Al-Arabi, rapporteur of the conference, in the large and small conference rooms in the faculty building.

Dr. Ahmed Wahban, Dean of the faculty, indicated that the conference discussed economic and political issues during its sessions, as it discussed on the economic side the issue of "digital transformation in light of the global pandemic, opportunities and challenges" and related issues, such as the Corona pandemic and the overlap between them, the issue of e-learning, the digital divide and ways to confront it, The conference also discussed the development and future of the digital economy in Egypt, the ethics of the digital economy, and discussed some aspects related to the Corona pandemic, such as its impact on the tourism sector in Egypt, and the impact of Corona on digital transformation and e-commerce, while addressing the role of financial technology in reducing the digital divide between rural and urban in Egypt. On the political side, the Dean of the College indicated that the conference discussed the topic of "The World Twenty Years After the September 11th events," as it touched upon many topics related to the changes that international politics witnessed during the twenty years, such as the growing international interest in the idea of the war on terrorism, and the decline in ideas and endeavors Globalization and democratization with the flourishing of populist ideas and systems, the growth of Islamophobia ideas, and the formation of a new international format that includes, along with the United States, There are two other polar powers, the Russian Federation and China, with some important changes at the level of international law in light of the decline in the concept of sovereignty, as many types of interference in the internal affairs of countries have emerged, such as international humanitarian intervention, international intervention to combat terrorism, and international intervention to disarm weapons of mass destruction, and others.

The conference included five sessions, during which 22 papers were presented on the political and economic axes, with the participation of researchers from several Egyptian and Arab universities, namely Alexandria, Cairo, Zayed Emirates, Suez, Damanhour and 6th of October, in addition to researchers representing the Maat Center for Development, Democracy and Human Rights, and the Dialogue Center for Political and Media Studies.







# President of Alexandria University and the Deputy Minister of Higher Education Inaugurate the second international conference of the Faculty of Pharmacy PHS 2022

Professor Dr. Abdelaziz Konsowa, President of Alexandria University, and Dr. Yasser Refaat, Deputy Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, inaugurated Wednesday evening the second international conference of the Faculty of Pharmacy PHS 2022, which will last for two days.

In his speech, Dr. Konsowa confirmed that Alexandria University is keen to support the university's scientific research system, as a fundamental pillar in the shift towards a



knowledge economy, explaining that the university has launched several initiatives to encourage researchers to increase their output of applied scientific research, and the university is also establishing a technology park to link these outputs with industry and transfer the research results into products of economic value, in order to achieve the Egyptian state's vision of sustainable development in accordance with the 2030 strategy.

The university president announced the start of several projects during the coming period under the umbrella of Alexandria University to serve society and industry extensively. He also thanked the administration of the Faculty of Pharmacy for its efforts in publishing and supporting scientific research.

Meanwhile, Dr. Yasser Refaat, Deputy Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, emphasized the role of the ministry in providing an encouraging environment innovation within Egypt's Vision 2030. explaining that Science. Technology and Innovation Incentives Law contributed supporting to scientific research in Egypt. He



praised the role of the Faculty of Pharmacy and Alexandria University in achieving a huge leap in the field of scientific research during the past four years, as the number of published researches reached more than 10 thousand, appreciating their quality, as the percentage of scientific citations reached 45% higher than the global average, the percentage of scientific publication reached 78% published in Q1, Q2, and the

percentage of research in the medical and pharmaceutical sector 55%. He urged the researchers participating conference the discuss research projects that support the economy and the pharmaceutical industry.

The opening session of the conference was attended by Dr. Zahi Hawass, the famous archaeologist and former Minister of Antiquities, Dr. Jacqueline Azer,

Deputy Governor of Alexandria, Nihal Balbaa, Deputy Governor of Beheira, Dr. Ahmed Adel Abdel Hakim, Dean of the Faculty of Dentistry, in addition the presidents of the Universities of El Alamein, Pharos, and the Arab Academy for Science, Technology



& Maritime Transport, the former governor of Sharkia, the Head of Dentists' Syndicate, and the Undersecretary of the Ministry of Health in Alexandria, as well as a group of faculty members and representatives of major medical companies.

At the beginning of his speech, Dr. Konsowa conveyed the greetings and appreciation of Dr. Ayman Ashour, Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, to all participants in the conference, and confirmed that Alexandria University is proud to organize this conference, which is full of tremendous scientific content in the field of dentistry, where many dental affiliates around the world are keen to participate. He also said that the conference is accompanied by a selection of lectures and workshops to present all that is new in the field of dentistry, and an exhibition of the latest equipment and supplies from major medical companies.

Dr. Zahi Hawass presented a documentary about recent discoveries in the Pyramids and the Valley of the Kings. He reviewed the new discoveries related to King Tutankhamun and the history of the king's dynasty on the Western Bank of the Nile, and the relationship of the different dynasties of Pharaonic Egypt to the stage of 2500 BC.

The activities of the conference started yesterday at the Faculty of Science, and included several lectures, such as that delivered by Dr. Mohamed Kamal, Professor of Sports Injuries and Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Physical Education for Postgraduate Studies and Research, on "Nanotechnology Programs in Sportswear to Counter Climate Changes and their Relationship to Sports Injuries", while Dr. Hisham El-Askari, Executive Vice President for Space Projects and Missions Affairs at the

Egyptian Space Agency, and Professor of Remote Sensing and Earth Systems Sciences at Chapman University - USA, held an online lecture via Zoom technology, on "Climate Change and its Consequences." Dr. Amr El-Sammak, professor of marine environment and former CEO of the Environmental Affairs Agency, spoke about "Environment and Climate Change - Intertwined Relationships", while Dr. Ahmed Omran, Professor of Sports Injuries and Physical Rehabilitation for people with disabilities, and Head of the Sports Health and Biological Sciences Department, held a lecture on "Environmental Footprint and Conditions for Organizing Olympic Games".

### International Conference of Higher Institute of Public Health "Telehealth": Telemedicine has become a necessity at the present time to provide medical services to citizens

Dr. Ashraf Al-Ghandour, Vice President of Alexandria University for Graduate Studies and Research, inaugurated on Sunday the 27th of November the activities of the tenth international conference, organized by the Higher Institute of Public Health in cooperation with the World

Health Organization (Eastern Mediterranean Office) and Save the Children of the United Nations, under the auspices of their excellencies Professors Dr. Ayman Ashour, Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Dr. Khaled Abdel Ghaffar, Minister of Health and Population, Dr. Amr Talaat, Minister of Communications and Information Technology, and Dr. Abdelaziz Konsowa, President of Alexandria University.



The Conference held under the title "Telehealth" will last for two days, in the presence of Dr. Heba El-Qadi, Dean of the Higher Institute of Public Health, Dr. Engy Mohamed El-Ghitani, Vice-Community Service Environmental Development, Dr. Nisreen El-Nemr, Vice-Dean for Postgraduate Studies and Research Affairs, Dr. Naima Al-Qaseer. of Representative the World Health Organization in Egypt, and Dr. Mohamed Al-Jarallah, President of the Islamic Organization for Medical Sciences and former Kuwaiti



Minister of Health, Dr. Amira Tahio, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Health in Alexandria, engineer Hoda Dahroug, representative of the Ministry of Communication Technology and information technology, and a group of experts and those interested in public health from the Arab world, Africa, Europe and America, and faculty professors in Egyptian universities.

In his speech, Dr. Ashraf El-Ghandour stressed that the conference is hosting health experts from around the world, hoping that it will come out with

recommendations that contribute to improving the public health of all citizens. El-Ghandour stressed the importance of telemedicine in providing medical advice to patients remotely, especially citizens living in remote areas. He added that the COVID-19 pandemic was main incentive to develop digital transformation in the health sector and help patients by using telemedicine in various hospitals in the world. He also





stressed that the use of smart devices and artificial intelligence has become necessary in the medical sector to raise the level of health care to very advanced stages.

While Dr. Heba El-Qadi confirmed that the conference in its current session adopts an important topic, which is "telehealth", and new visions of public health in the third millennium are presented during its sessions. The conference also addresses many aspects of the concept of telehealth, its present and future, its role in emergency situations, its advantages and disadvantages, its structure, and its role in scientific research. Dr. El-Qadi indicated that the first session of the conference is titled "Health Perception from a Distance", during which the keynote speaker will be Dr. Hisham Kouzou, Professor of Hearing and Balance Medicine at the Faculty of Medicine at Alexandria University, member of the Digital Transformation Committee of the Supreme Council of University Hospitals, the academic supervisor of electronic health programs and a member of the Department of Medical Education, Faculty of Medicine. Also participating in the other sessions are Dr. Engy Mohamed El-Ghitani, Professor in the Tropical Medicine Department at the Higher Institute of Public Health at Alexandria University, and Dr.

Nisreen El-Nimr, Professor of Epidemiology at the Institute of Public Health.

Dr. Muhammad Al-Jarallah indicated that academic studies have proven the importance of e-health, especially after the spread of COVID-19, confirming that it is not possible to achieve a bright future for public health without achieving progress in digital health and the Internet. Al-Jarallah appealed to governments and medical institutions to support and develop digital health programs and artificial intelligence, in order to catch up with progress in the medical field.

Dr. Amira Tahio thanked the organizing committee of the conference for giving young doctors at the Ministry of Health the opportunity to present research papers for the first time at this international conference. She indicated that the Ministry of Health hopes for more cooperation with Alexandria University to train doctors, present research papers and contribute to development and community service.

Engineer Hoda Dahroug confirmed that telemedicine is a presidential initiative in cooperation with the Ministry of Health, pointing out that information and communication technology contributed to improving public health after the spread of COVID-19, and confirmed that this service is now available in remote villages and governorates.





#### Council of community services cooperation agreements -Dec 2022



The Council approved a cooperation agreement between the College of Computing and Data Science and the Holding Company for Maritime Transport to implement some training programs and develop skills for workers and implement a number of technological and programming activities in the company.

The Council approved the renewal of the cooperation agreement between Alexandria University, represented by the Community Service Center and the AMIDEAST Egypt Assistance Authority, for the third year to coordinate the English language tests "TOEFL ITP" and the international communication tests service in the English language "TOEIC."

The Council also approved a cooperation protocol between the Institute of Graduate Studies and Research and the Alexandria Specialized Petroleum Products Company (ASPEC) to develop the capabilities of workers, benefit from the scientific expertise of the Institute, create training opportunities for university students, and cooperate in the engineering, technical, and research fields.

The Council approved a cooperation protocol between the College of Commerce, the Computer Center and Skills Plus for Skills Development.

The Council was informed of the report submitted by the Vice Dean of the College of Commerce regarding the College's organization of the Sixth Forum of Companies and Banks to educate students about the requirements of the labor market.

The Council also took note of the video report submitted by the Vice Dean of the College of Pharmacy on the College's second international conference, PHS 2022, which was held under the title of Egypt's Healthcare Vision 2030.

The Council discussed a number of activities and events in a number of university colleges as follows:

- The College of Education organized an initiative entitled "Sinai in the Heart" to raise students' awareness of the value of the land of Sinai and its great history. The college also provided usufruct outlets to provide government and student services, "distinctive and urgent services," to faculty members, students, workers, and graduates.
- Activities of the College of Pharmacy in the field of preserving environmental cleanliness and combating climate change.
- The College of Agriculture organized a number of agricultural convoys to the areas of Burj Al-Arab, Ibis 7, 8, and Al-Ameriya, in cooperation with the Directorate of Agriculture in Alexandria, as well as the activities of the college's cultural season and the most important activities accompanying them.
- The report submitted by the College of Physical Education on the first scientific forum on sports medicine and locomotor system research, "Critical Sports Injuries," and the scientific forum, "Wellness, Sports, and Climate Change."
