Within the framework of Alexandria University's adoption of UNESCO recommendations regarding open education and science, and under the patronage of the President of Alexandria University, the University's Educational Innovations and Distance Learning Unit is participating in the Open2Sustain project for Euro-Mediterranean Sustainable Development, funded by the Francophone University Agency.
