

The Supreme Council of Universities approves the terms of reference and formation of sector committees



Chaired by Prof. Dr. Ayman Ashour, Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, and the secretariat of Prof. Mostafa Refaat, Secretary of the Council the Supreme Council of Universities adopted the terms of reference and formation of sector committees. for the new session 2025-2028, with the aim of unifying higher and university education policies, qualification and training in all Egyptian higher education institutions. The Supreme Council of Universities adopted the formation and terms of reference of the university education sector committees for the new sector committee for interdisciplinary sciences In line with the scientific and technological development and the state's keen interest in human development, education and scientific research, the political leadership; and to keep pace with the rapid changes in science, technology and scientific research, to achieve the desired goals through a number of strategic axes, the most important of which are three main axes, namely: The first axis: Drawing and planning university and higher education policies in Egypt according to an integrated vision, in coordination and cooperation with the concerned authorities in the country , the second axis: Linking the current curricula of colleges and institutes with training and qualification mechanisms for entrepreneurship, in light of the current and future labor market needs, and to meet the requirements of future jobs , and the third axis: Working on a project to develop faculty members and support staff in Egyptian universities to address the deficit in some specialties and scientific

fields, and to develop a mechanism that ensures the preservation of manpower from migration abroad. To achieve this, Prof. Dr. Mustafa Refaat, Secretary General of the Supreme Council of Universities, took charge of ensuring that the mechanisms and rules achieve the optimal selection of leaders and members, and that the scientific fields of university education sectors are in line with scientific fields and specializations according to international academic standards, and assigning the new formation with tasks consistent with strategic plans.
