

10.6.5. Council of Community Services (equity and diversity) , and Environmental Affairs.

Alexandria University strengthens equity, inclusion, and social justice through its Council of Community Services and Environmental Affairs, led by Prof. Afaf El Owfy. The Council brings together leaders from all faculties to address inequality, support diverse population groups, and improve access to services for students and staff from different residence characteristics, ethnic groups, and socioeconomic backgrounds.

Through evidence-based policies, community programs, and campus-wide initiatives, the Council promotes fairness, equal opportunity, and positive outcomes while advancing sustainable development and environmental responsibility across the University.

Alexandria University has a dedicated committee for the community services and environmental affairs headed by Prof. Afaf El Owfy. Prof El Owfy is the vice president of Alexandria university. The committee is composed of the vice deans of the 24 institutions of Alexandria University who have many responsibilities among which is the diversity and equality committee of students and staff members.

This committee is a tasked administration or governing body to advise on and implement policies, programmes, and trainings related to community development, diversity, equity, inclusion and human rights on campus.
